- A web server is a computer system that stores and serves web pages to other computers (clients) over a network.

How does a Web Server work?

Web Server

- A client (browser) sends a request to the web server.
- The web server processes the request and returns the requested data (HTML, CSS, JavaScript, etc.) to the client.
- The client renders the data and displays it to the user.
